Uniform

The league provides a Jersey and Hat. *(Socks and belt depending on availability)*

Parents supply the pants

Glove

All players should have a glove that fits the player's hand (not too big). Glove sizes are in inches.

A general rule of thumb for glove sizes is as follows

- 9" to 10" for players 5-6 years old
- 9 1/2" to 10 1/2" for players 7-8 yrs old
- 10" to 10 1/2" for players 9-10 yrs old
- 10 1/2" to 11" for players 11-12 yrs old

Helmet

All players must wear a batting helmet. It is not recommended that helmets be shared.

Cup

Players in Minors division and above are encouraged to wear a protective cup.

Catchers **MUST** wear a protective cup

Bats

Bats have what is called a "drop" number. This is calculated by subtracting the length from the weight. So, a 20 oz bat that is 30 inches long is a -10 or drop 10. Drop numbers for Majors and below range from -10 to -14. Heavier baseball bats provide more power, while lighter baseball bats will give a player more bat control and increased bat speed. The exact weight will be a personal preference. As far as length the following chart provides good guidelines.

Sports equipment can be an expensive proposition. Please read below to avoid making a costly mistake acquiring a new bat..

Bat Requirements

TBall Divisions

Starting on January 1, 2018, all Tee Ball bats in the Little League Baseball® Tee Ball program must feature the USA Baseball mark and accompanying text.

Coach Pitch Divisions

Starting on January 1, 2018, all bats in the Little League Baseball® program must feature the USA Baseball mark and accompanying text.

Minors & Majors Divisions

USA Baseball marking

2 5/8" barrel maximum

Intermediate (50/70) & Junior Divisions

USA or BBCOR allowed

NO BBCOR ALLOWED

Senior Division

ALL bats must be BBCOR

“USAAA” baseball bats are NOT permitted in Little League. Please check the stamp on the bat handle and ensure it says “USA”
